SUPPLIES

Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot
Thread
Rotary Cutter • Mat • Ruler
Scissor • Seam Ripper • Straight Pins

FABRICS

I love to play with 5" Square Charm Packs
and
10" Square "Layer Cake" Fabric Packs

These type of packs have about 40 different fabrics in each set and are fun to work with. If you have them bring them and I'll show you how to put them to good use.

If you do not...

Go through your stash of fabrics and cut some squares and strips. You do not need 40 of each group.

5" squares • Need: 20 different fabric squares

10" squares • Need: 10 different squares

Controlled Four Patch

Need:

1 Fussy cut 5" square • 1 solid fabric 5" square • two stripe fabric squares (same fabric)

Throw in 2 • Fat Quarters for something new I'm working on.
